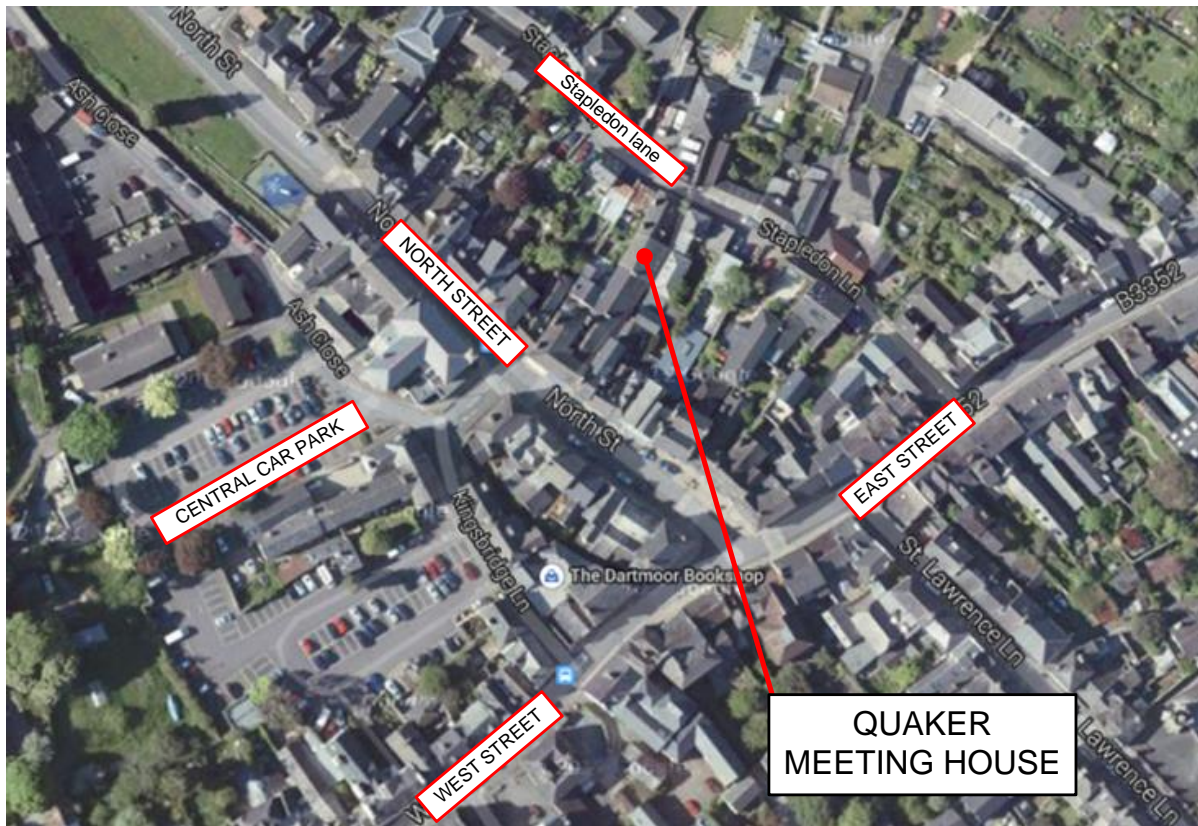


ASHBURTON QUAKER MEETING HOUSE
FOALES COURT, off NORTH STREET, ASHBURTON, TQ13 7QE



DIRECTIONS

As shown on the map, the Meeting House is situated about halfway up a narrow lane, Foales Court, which runs between North Street and Stapledon Lane in the middle of Ashburton. It can easily be reached on foot from the central car park by crossing over North Street. The entrance to Foales Court lies between a shop with the name Serenity to the left and the Ashburton Delicatessen to the right. There is some disabled car parking towards the southern end of North Street.

PARKING

Parking is possible in the central car park at a cost of £1 for three hours, but like many towns it may be difficult to find a parking space, especially on a Saturday. There is only limited street parking unless you park some distance from the centre of town. On 26th October it may be especially busy because of the three Two Moors Festival concerts which are taking place in the town, one of which is at lunchtime. So it is suggested that you try to arrive in plenty of time if coming by car.

BUSES

For those wishing to travel to Ashburton by bus, there are good, though not frequent, services from and to Exeter, Plymouth, Totnes and Newton Abbot on Saturday 26th October. All services stop at the lower end of West Street (The Bull Ring) – not far from the Meeting House.

From Exeter (X38): 12.41 arriving at 13.30 (returning from Ashburton at 16.01 and 17.33)

From Plymouth (X38): 12.38 arriving at 13.38 (returning from Ashburton at 17.38)

From Totnes (88/88C): 12.40 arriving at 13.17 (returning from Ashburton at 17.12)

From Newton Abbot (88/88C): 13.10 arriving at 13.37 (returning from Ashburton at 16.50 or 17.20)
