"...Or Whatever You Call It"

This one-day workshop is for Quaker Meetings who wish to explore how Quakers speak, or sometimes don't speak, about God, the Light, the Spirit, or whatever you call it. The workshops use Rhiannon Grant's PhD research on Quaker uses of religious language and philosophical tools which can help us to understand them, and encourage a reflective mode of participation which allows us to dig deeper into the issues raised.

The workshop is free to attendees and is supported by the Gerald Hodgett Award Scheme which offers grants of up to £1000 per applicant for the dissemination of research findings for the benefit of Britain Yearly Meeting (BYM), its Meetings and members by students and graduates of Quaker Studies and related post-graduate research. The annual awards are agreed each year by the Higher Education Awards Group
