

Joining instructions for the Friends Meeting house in Exeter

The postal address:

Friends Meeting House, Wynards Lane, Magdalen Street, Exeter EX2 4HU **Grid reference:** SX924923

Trains:

The main train station is Exeter St Davids, approx a mile and a quarter away, although Exeter Central is closer to the meeting house at about three quarters of a mile away. The taxi fare from St Davids is about £7. If you are coming by train in a party for certain Quaker events, we may be able to pick up you from Exeter St David's station. See the contact details below, and tell us your needs.

Buses and coaches:

The bus and coach station(less than half a mile away) is surrounded by Sidwell Street, Paris Street and Cheeke Street. The H bus (H1 or H2) travels between the train and bus stations.

By road – park & ride facilities:

In the south of Exeter and sign-posted from main roads, is the Matford Park & Ride, near EX2 8FD. This GREEN service takes passengers on a 15 minute journey every ten minutes to South Street, approximately half a mile from the Meeting House.

In the east of Exeter lie Honiton Road Park & Ride (the RED service near EX2 7NL – 18 minute journey, every 12 minutes) and Sowton Park & Ride (the BLUE service near EX2 5GL – 16 minute journey, every 12 minutes) each of which takes passengers to the bus station. Note that services PR3 from Digby Park & Ride (destination the hospital) and PR6 from Sowton (destination County Hall) do not go to the city centre.
